## Compounded Therapy Options for SHINGLES PAIN & POSTHERPETIC NEURALGIA

We regularly receive calls inquiring about any topical options that we can prepare for pain related to shingles rash (Herpes Zoster). This rash can occur on various areas of the body and is quite painful. Typical drug therapy for pain management is either non-effective or causes undesirable side effects (most notably drowsiness and/or anticholinergic effects). At Moss Compounding Pharmacy we can compound a variety of topical treatment options that can provide pain relief while minimizing side effects.

Some commonly requested COMPOUNDED formulations are listed below:

Name	SIG	Quantity	Notes
Gabapentin 5%/ Lidocaine 2.5% Transdermal Gel	Apply to the affected area BID-TID PRN.	30gm – 60gm	Avoid applying on eyelids or close to eyes. #1 initial option Price = \$45 per 30gm
Gabapentin 5%/ Amitriptyline 2%/ Lidocaine 2% Transdermal Gel (aka. GAL Gel)	Apply to the affected area BID-TID PRN.	30gm – 60gm	Avoid applying on eyelids or close to eyes. Concentrations of ingredients can be adjusted as needed. Option if enhanced nerve pain control needed.  Price = \$49 per 30gm
Deoxy-D-Glucose 0.2%/ Gabapentin 5%/ Amitriptyline 2%/ Tetracaine 1% Transdermal Gel	Apply to the affected area BID-TID PRN.	30gm – 60gm	Anti-viral + stronger pain control option  Price = \$65 per 30gm

Additional ingredients that can be used in compounded treatment combinations include:

- Ketamine
- Acyclovir
- Ketoprofen
